#### **CONFERENCE MESSAGE FROM THE 2024 PRESIDENT**

Hello SCJA!

It has been a busy and exciting year since our last issue of Crime and Grits. I am happy to share with you a recap of our 2023 Conference in Mobile, our mid-year meeting at ACJS in Chicago, and to highlight our upcoming SCJA meeting this September 2024 in Greenville, SC!

In September of 2023 we were at the Battle House Renaissance Mobile Hotel. The hotel was beautiful and maintains much of its historical look. I think everyone was impressed by both the historical grand lobby and the contemporary meeting spaces available to us. We offered 23 panels and roundtables and 27 posters throughout the week. We had just over 150 people preregister for the conference and 35 register onsite. Our membership numbers remain healthy at 262 which includes 60 students and 71 lifetime members. Dr. John Sloan, Professor Emeritus at UAB, was the keynote speaker at our Awards Luncheon and shared with us some of his work on the ACJS Directory Project. Award recipients included Teresa Collier, as our Outstanding Professional. She works with the Child Trafficking Solutions Project; Dr. John Stogner, UNCC, is our Educator of the Year; Ter'Ricka Brundidge of UAB received the Tom Barker Outstanding Undergraduate award; the Outstanding Master's Student is Shelby Gilbreath from the University of Mississippi; and McKenzie Josie, UF, is our Outstanding Doctoral Student. Congratulations, again, to all of our award winners. Nominations for our 2024 Awards are open and are due in late June to early July. 
